

## Where to look for gay friendly private rented accommodation

Try the notice board (downstairs at the back of the bar on the left), @ the **First Out Café Bar**, 52 St Giles High Street London WC2H 8LH. The number is 020 7240 8042, and their website is [www.firstoutcafebar.com](http://www.firstoutcafebar.com)

**Outlet** are an agency that rents exclusively to LGBT people. Find their offices @ 32 Old Compton Street, London W1D 4TP, or call them on 020 7287 4244

It's always worth checking the **Pink Paper**, which sometimes advertises for people looking for flatmates. You can pick up a free Pink Paper at most LGBT pubs and clubs around London, and a new issue is published every two weeks.

**Loot** is the main paper that advertises accommodation all over London. You can look for whole houses or flats to share with a group of friends, or you can look for rooms in flats just for you. Check the adverts, some people will state that they are gay friendly. You can buy Loot from most newsagents, it is published weekly.
